
- 28th June Non-Uniform Day We have a non-uniform day to collect chocolate prizes for the Summer Fete (instead of bringing in cash)

Take time to assess your surroundings.

Look for the dangers and always research local sians and advice.



When around water always go with friends or family.

Swim at a lifeguarded venue.

IN AN EMERGENCY



Ask for the Fire and Rescue Service when inland and the Coastguard if at the coast.

Don't enter the water to rescue.



Fall in or become tired – stay calm, float on your back and call for help.

Throw something that floats to somebody that has fallen in.
