EXTENDED CHILDCARE ENTITLEMENTS

REMINDER TO PARENTS

Do not ignore your HMRC reminder for renewing!



Please be aware that it is your responsibility to renew your codes for the 30 hour funding and the new entitlements!

When to apply

You can apply from when your child is:

- 1 year and 36 weeks for 15 hours free childcare
- 2 years and 36 weeks for 30 hours free childcare



If you already receive Tax Free Childcare your reconfirmation date for the new entitlements will be the same as your Tax Free Childcare date!



Late renewal will mean delayed funding!

If applying for the new entitlements and Tax Free Childcare, make your application for the new entitlements first as this will help with your reconfirmation date!



Football updates...

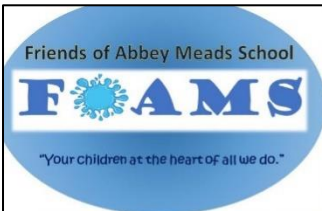
Well done to our two teams on their recent performances.
