Year 6 have a busy start to term




<u>Deadline for submitting questions etc is Friday 29th September</u> (so that people have enough notice whether they need to attend school at 6pm on 9th October or not).

Well done boys on your achievements, it is excellent that you have been given the opportunity to swim outside school.










Look at the chart and say the **COLOUR** not the word


